Lesson plan for teaching speaking online designed by Group 2:

Aim of this teaching speaking session: To develop students' ability to speak fluently and interactively regarding the topic "Equitable Education" SDG 4.

LESSON OBJECTIVES (how?)

By the end of this lesson the learners will:

- 1. Discuss in groups about factors affecting equitable education and its consequences for 5 minutes
- 2. Discuss in groups (within 10 minutes) and prepare a 5-minute presentation about solutions for equitable education.

Assumed knowledge:

- Students have basic knowledge of phrases to express ideas and opinions.
- Students are familiar with Zoom, Jamboard, Mentimeter, Genially and have accounts on these platforms.

Teaching aids: Zoom, Google Slides, Mentimeter, Jamboard, Genially, Wheel of names.
